- 3) Safety Management Plan – This manual was prepared by ASCC’s Safety Council to help contractors develop and implement a basic safety management plan that can be customized to meet the needs of individual companies. The Plan covers policy statements, safety responsibilities, inspections, accident investigation, safety meetings, rules, training, recordkeeping, first aid, emergency planning, hazard communication, concrete construction, electrical safety, fall protection, confined spaces, lock-out/tag-out, scaffolding, trenching and excavating and substance abuse.
